

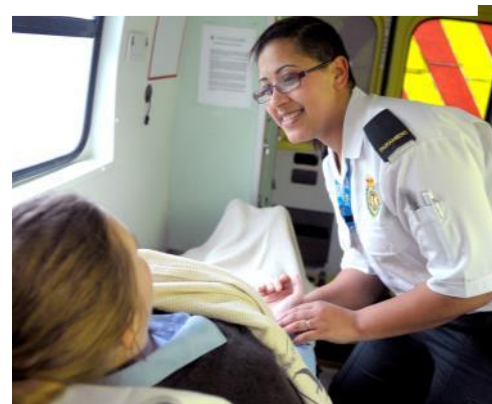
## Thinking of returning to your role as a healthcare professional? We can help you!
