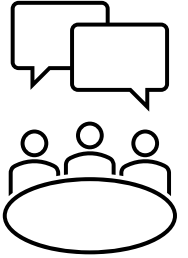

Discussion 1 – Introductions

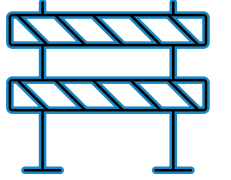


1) Introduce yourself and your role.

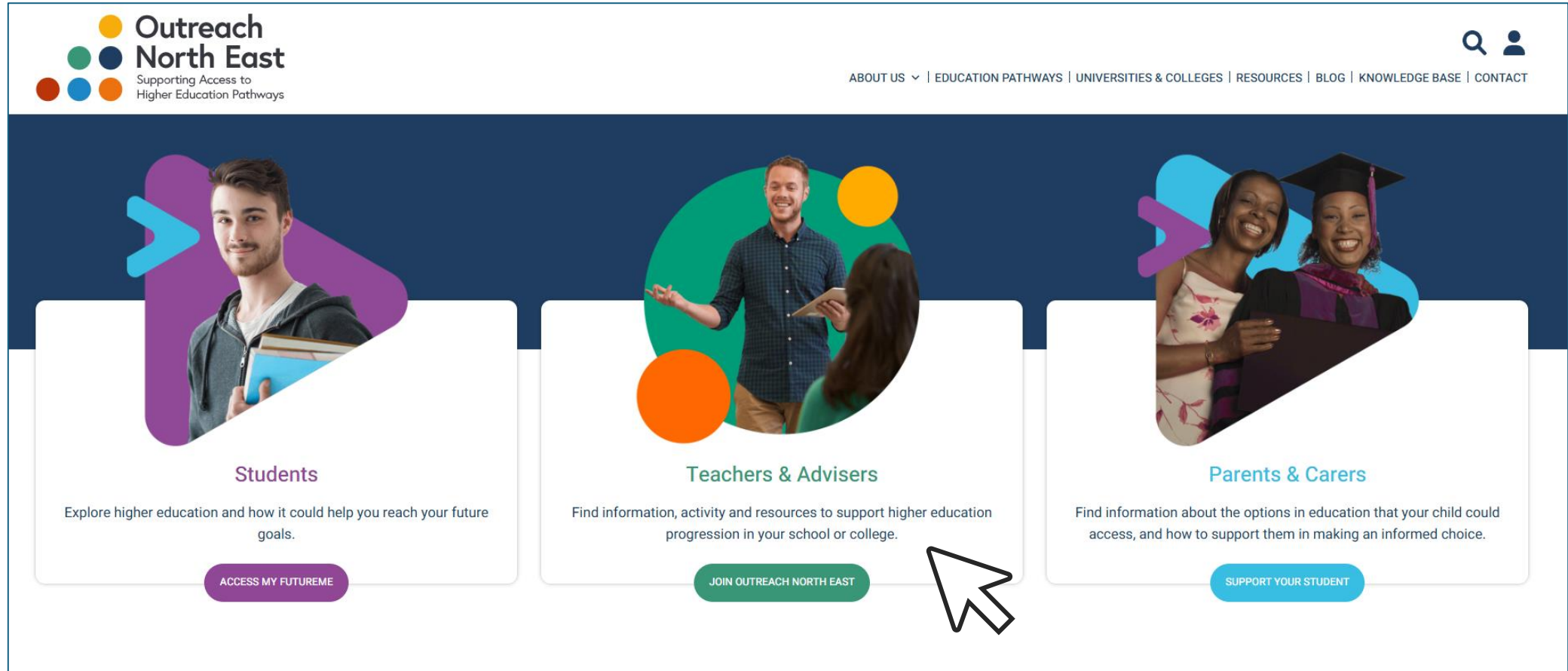

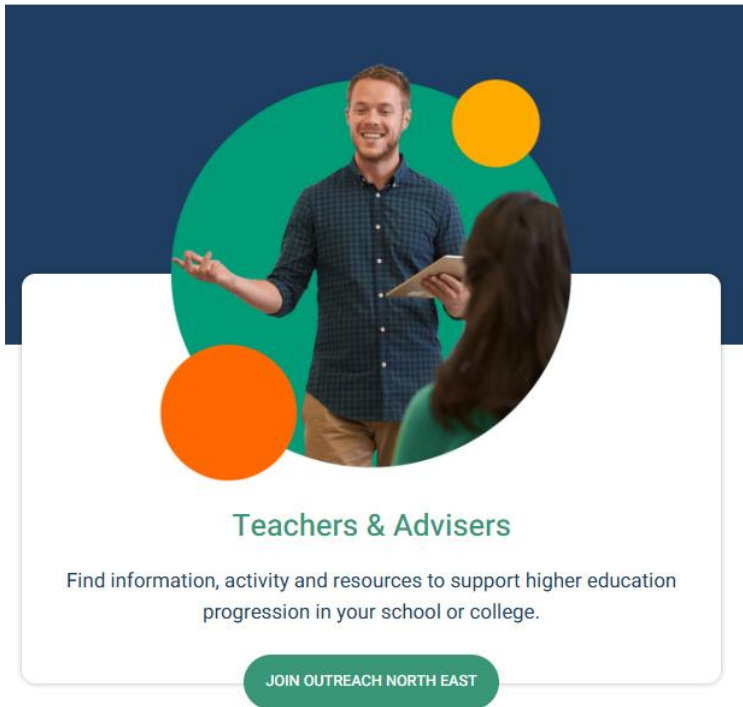
